### ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

- IELTS 6.0
- Equivalent results on an "internationally recognised test"
- Duolingo online test results acceptable
- Academie English Placement test result of 70% or above

### EDUCATION PROOF

- Completed high school is generally adequate

Students study between 3 to 7 units across an eight - study week term then have a 2 week " research break". Students are required to participate in the training as a condition of their visa.

Students must log a minimum of 400 supervised, 'paid' or 'unpaid', work experience hours.

The student is responsible for collecting evidence proving the supervised 'paid' work experience hours. All work placements must be approved before starting work. We can help you to find suitable "Vocational Placement".


